Airport Transit Visa Checklist		
1	Application form to be filled in completely and signed by the applicant.	
2	One recent passport-size photographs in colour with white background.	
3	The Passport should be valid for atleast three months after the intended date of departure from the territory of the Member States or, in case of several visits, after the last intended date of departure from the territory of the Member States.	
4	Copy of Schengen Visas, USA & UK Visa.	
5	Valid Visa for the third country of destination	
6	Air Ticket of onward journey	
7	Original letter from the company specifying reason for stay in Greece, Employment status & Salary.	
8	Overseas medical insurance valid for all Schengen-countries with a minimum coverage of 30,000 Euro. The insurance has to cover all risk e.g. accident, illness, etc. The policy has to clearly specify the period of validity and has to cover the date of arrival & departure has to be submitted in original. Applicant also has to sign the Health Policy declaration which can be downloaded from the website.	
9	Proof of sufficient Funds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Original Personal bank statements* for last six months. ○ Original Company's bank statements* of last six months. ○ Personal Income Tax Return for the last three years. ○ Company's Income Tax Return for the last three years. ○ Salary Slips for the last six months. ○ Credit Card copy/Foreign Exchange endorsement/Traveler's Cheque. ○ Copy of PAN Card 	
10	Previous passport may also be required by the Embassy.	

Note: Applicant would be asked for additional documents or may be called for an Interview if desired by The Embassy of Greece
