Seaman Visa Checklist		
1	Application form to be filled in completely and signed by the applicant.	
2	One recent passport-size photographs in colour with white background.	
3	The Passport should be valid for at least Six months beyond the intended duration of stay in the Schengen territory.	
4	Copy of Schengen Visas.	
5	Return air ticket reservations.	
6	A letter of guarantee from shipping company and Appointment Letter/Contract.	
7	Medical fitness certificate (for contagious diseases according to WHO) attested by the ministry of external affairs, Consular division, Patiala house, New Delhi with an Apostile Sticker.	
8	Valid seaman's record book	
9	Copy of Certificates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Personal safety and social responsibility. ○ Personal survival techniques. ○ Elementary first aid. ○ Fire prevention and fire fighting. ○ On watch keeping. 	
10	A copy of CDC (Continuous Discharge Certificate).	

Note: Applicant would be asked for additional documents or may be called for an Interview if desired by The Embassy of Greece
The visa fee, according to Schengen regulations, is non-refundable
Original documents submitted must be accompanied along with a copy

1. Application of the shipping company/agent mentioning: seaman's name, nationality, date of birth, passport number, rank in the ship, date of arrival and departure from/to Schengen, boarding date of the seaman, data of local shipping/manning agency
2. Declaration of LAW 1599/1986 whereas shipping agent undertakes responsibility for expenses and return of the seaman in India
3. In case the application is submitted by shipping agent, attestation from shipping/manning company whereas it is mentioned that authorizes the shipping agent (directly to Consular Office fax)
